THE TOURIST OFFER IN AND AROUND METZ

 Metz has been classed as a Tourist Resort since February 2015 and as a City of Art and History since November 2011



- Urban tourism: the extraordinary heritage of Metz, dating from the second half of the 19th century to the beginning of the 20th century, has led it to feature in the National Committee of French World Heritage Sites since 2014, in view of UNESCO's 'Royal & Imperial Metz' classification.
- Themed visits to explore 3000 years of history in Metz, from the Gallo-Roman period to our time: baths, ramparts, the *Porte des Allemands* (Germans Gateway), medieval sites, Saint-Pierre-aux-Nonnains, Cathédrale Saint Etienne (6500m² of stained glass windows from the 13th 20th centuries), 18th century squares, the Imperial and Amphithéâtre districts, the Centre Pompidou-Metz. The guided tour of the cathedral has a Tourism and Handicap classification for three types of disability (motor, visual and mental).
- Garden Tourism: Jean-Marie Pelt Gardens, Botanical Gardens, Parc de l'Île du Saulcy, Tanners' Garden, Garden of the Five Senses, parks of the Grange aux Bois and Pas du Loup, the Esplanade, gardens of Lakes Symphonie and Ariane, Jardin sans Limite at Robert Schuman's house, gardens at the Château de Pange, walks beside the Canal de Jouy, on the banks of the Moselle and the Seille, in the Parc du Château de Courcelles.



- River tourism and water sports: marina awarded European Blue Flag in 2007.
- Active Tourism (tennis, golf, cycling, hiking): in November 2013, Metz gained the Fédération Française du Cyclotourisme's cyclefriendly classification, and in February 2017 the classification Ville Active et Sportive.



- Tourism Events: the Mirabelle Festival and Metz Plage, Christmas Markets ...
- Sports Tourism: the Metz Mirabelle Marathon, Handball
- Business Tourism: the Robert Schuman Congress Centre (opening 2018) and many venues for meetings and seminars
- Military History Tourism: Fort de Queuleu, ramparts
- **Technical Tourism:** Metz' Electricity plant, the Republican Lorraine, Mirabelle production and wines from the Moselle region
- Museums / Cultural Sites: Centre Pompidou-Metz; the *Cour d'Or* museum; the Regional Foundation of Contemporary Art; Robert Schuman's House in Scy-Chazelles; Roman aqueduct at Jouy aux Arches; fortified churches of Metz' countryside; Mont St Quentin: sites of natural, ecological and educational interest.
