Tourism in Metz and its surroundings


◆ Metz has been classified as a tourist resort since February 2015 and 'City of Art and History' since November 2011



- ♦ Urbain tourisme: Metz's extraordinary heritage from the second half of the 19th to the beginning of the 20th century has been on the indicative list of the National Committee of French World Heritage Properties since January 2014 for a UNESCO classification for 'Metz Royal ⊕ Imperial'
- ↑ Themed visits to discover Metz: 3000 years of intramural history from the Gallo-Roman era to the present day: thermal baths, ramparts, Germans Gateway, medieval ensembles, Saint-Pierre-aux-Nonnains, Saint Etienne Cathedral (6,500m² of stained glass from the 13th to the 20th century), 18th century squares, Imperial District, Amphitheatre District, Centre Pompidou-Metz. The guided visit of the cathedral has the tourism and disability label for 3 types of disability (physical, visual and mental)
- ♦ Garden tourism: Jean-Marie Pelt Gardens, Botanical Garden, Saulcy Isle, Tanners Garden, Garden of the 5 senses, Grange aux Bois Park, Pas du Loup Park, Esplanade, Symphony and Ariane lakes, Garden at Robert Schuman's House, Grounds of the Château de Pange, Walks along the Jouy canal or the banks of the Moselle and the Seille, Grounds of the Château de Courcelles, Laquenexy Fruit Gardens
- ♠ River tourism 8 water sports: Blue flag marina since 2007



- ◆ Remembrance tourism: Fort de Queuleu, ramparts
- ◆ Event tourism: Constellations of Metz, Mirabelle Festival, Metz Beach, Christmas Markets





- Business tourism: The Metz Robert Schuman Congress Centre (Sept. 2018) and various meeting rooms
- ◆Technical tourism: Metz Electricity Plant, production of Mirabelles and Moselle wines in the Metz region
- ◆ Museums / Cultural Sites: the Centre Pompidou-Metz; the Cour d'Or Museum; the Regional Modern Art Centre; Verlaine's House; Robert Schuman's House at Scy-Chazelles; the Roman aqueduct at Jouy aux Arches; the fortified churches in the Metz region; Mont St Quentin: natural and educational site
